
NYC RENOVATION NEIGHBORHOOD SNAPSHOT

TREND HIGHLIGHTS 2018 vs. 2017

- Tribeca and West Village grew 67% and 64%, respectively
- First time Lower East Side made the top 5 list
- Battery Park City renos down -64% after huge gains in the previous year



TREND HIGHLIGHTS 2018 vs. 2017

- Bed-Stuy breaks into the top 5, nudging out Williamsburg from the previous year
- Bushwick renovation pace doubled (perhaps homeowners wanted to tackle renovation during the period of the anticipated L Train shutdown?)
- Prospect Heights moved down the list from #2 in 2017 to #4 in 2018





- Forest Hills maintains its top spot, but 3 of the top 5 changed yearover-year; Woodside, Astoria and Rego Park were replaced by LIC, Sunnyside and Jamaica Estates
